On April 28, 2009 the Credit Union ONE Board of Directors passed a resolution acknowledging Mr. Coyne for his long years of service and dedication, which will be presented to him in May.

Mr. Coyne retired from Ferndale Schools, where he served as Superintendent of Schools for twenty years. Previous to this position, he was the Elementary School Principle at Taft Elementary, and was Assistant Principle at Lincoln Junior High School in Ferndale. Mr. Coyne also served as a Counselor at both Ferndale High School and Lincoln Junior High School. Before his career in Ferndale, Mr. Coyne was an elementary school teacher and substitute truant officer in Detroit Schools for five years at Foch Junior High School.

He is a graduate of Michigan State University, earning a Bachelor’s degree in Elementary Education. He also earned his Master’s degree in Counseling and a Specialist’s certificate in Education from Wayne State University.
