

Gary A. Moody – Biography

Gary A. Moody is president and chief executive officer at Credit Union ONE.

As President/CEO, Moody leads one of Michigan's largest credit unions, serving over 118,000 members and small businesses statewide.

Moody served as vice president of strategic alliances and chief counsel for Credit Union ONE (CUO) and its affiliates, before accepting the position of President/CEO in 2006. Moody also was a member of the CUO Board of Directors from 2001 to 2004; the last year as its Vice Chairman.



Prior to joining the credit union, Moody was in private law and consulting practice serving financial institutions.

His career in financial services began at the Michigan Financial Institutions Bureau (FIB), now known as the Office of Financial and Insurance Services. Moody was appointed by Governor Engler to serve as a policy advisor to the Bureau's commissioner.

Moody left the FIB to accept the position of Senior Director of Legislative and Regulatory Affairs at the Michigan Credit Union League (MCUL), where he served as chief lobbyist, representing Michigan credit unions at both the state and federal levels. His role was later expanded to Vice President of Government and Public Affairs where he managed the MCUL's government and public relations, media advocacy efforts, and its office of general counsel.

A Michigan native for most of his life, Moody earned a bachelor's degree with a major in social science-teaching from Michigan State University, and his juris doctorate from Detroit College of Law.
